Walt served in the Army in World War II, in the Pacific. After the war he moved to Saint Paul, where he met Millie. They were married on February 19, 1950, in White Bear Lake, Minnesota. They had eight children in the next 11 years. On May 28, 1963, at age 39, Millie died of cancer, leaving Walt alone to raise eight children, ages 2 to 12 years old. Walt died on June 4, 1989, at age 75 years old, of heart disease. Walt & Millie left a legacy of eight children, their spouses, 17 grandchildren, 19 great-grandchildren and 2 great-great-grandchildren.

On May 28th it will be 60 years since our mother died, and on June 4 it will be 34 years since our father died. I am thankful for growing up in a large family.

Happy Memorial Day, as we remember those who have died and how they touched our lives.

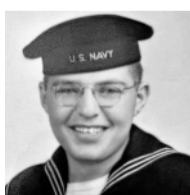

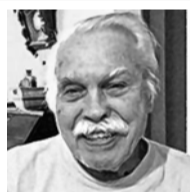

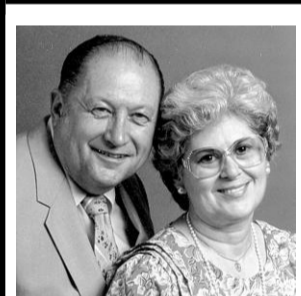
